

Corona No. 38 | New regulations from July 3rd, 2021

June 29, 2021

Dear university community,

As we announced in our last Corona email, the Berlin Senate has now decided on the next opening steps in the ordinance from 3.7. onwards, which will also apply to universities:

From July 3rd, the universities are no longer closed to the public

We can finally meet your request and allow external guests, such as family members, to be present at the final exams.

However, this is not a general opening of the buildings: the universities are still subject to the hygiene rules, the maximum occupancy of the halls and the obligation to carry out attendance documentation.

Therefore, unfortunately, the following rules must still apply:

- Only persons who are registered in the ASIMUT spatial program have access to the buildings.
- External guests of an (examination) audition/audition must be entered in Asimut, in the description field by the teacher. The admission of guests to the exams is the responsibility of the respective teacher. Guests have to register at the porters upon arrival.
- The maximum occupancy of the halls continues to apply (GKS I + II = max. 12 people / KKS = max. 16 people at the same time).
- All persons present in the hall are to be documented by the teachers on the attendance card. Guests must enter their full contact details on this.
- If more than 7 people are present in the room at the same time, they must all have submitted a daily negative result of a corona test or proof of a completed vaccination, which must also be documented on the attendance card.

Vaccinations

Our company doctor has received additional batches of vaccine that can be distributed to university members. There is still free capacity for the upcoming date on July 2nd, 2021. Please register with our company doctor if you would like to have a vaccination (see e-mail from June 24th, 2021 "Vaccination offer for all university members").

Test obligation from July 3rd, 2021

The test regulations from April 9th, 2021 still apply. As many of you have received a vaccine in the meantime, it is no longer necessary for vaccinated / recovered people to test!

The following persons are exempt from the obligation to test:

- Vaccinated persons who have been vaccinated with a vaccine approved by the European Union and whose last required vaccination was at least 14 days ago.
- Recovered persons who can prove a positive PCR test result for an infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus more than six months ago and who have received at least one vaccination against Covid-19 with a vaccine approved by the European Union.
- Recovered persons who can show a positive PCR test result for an infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus from at least 28 days and no more than six months ago.

Still compulsory: FFP2 masks

According to the ordinance and for the protection of everyone, it is still required to wear a FFP2 mask in all buildings of the university until further notice.

Moving through the buildings

Good news for the university members on the upper floors: The one-way system in the buildings is no more! In addition, two people can now use the elevators at the same time.

Regulations for the administrative staff

A transitional regulation for mobile working comes into force from July to September. The "Employee Information VII" was sent to the administration in a separate email from the ServiceCenter staff.
