

No. 3/ Coronavirus: Important Information for HFM Members

Dear students,

due to the spread of the new coronavirus we would like to inform you about current measures being taken by the Hochschule Hanns Eisler.

The university management's most important task is the responsibility towards employees. Hanns Eisler school has updated the pandemic plan and set up a crisis committee which meets at frequent intervals in order to evaluate the situation and necessary actions.

The Hanns Eisler Crisis Committee has made the following decision on 6/3/2020:

All those returning from the high risk areas as defined by the Robert Koch Institute are **not** allowed to enter the school within two weeks of their return. We kindly ask you to place yourself in domestic quarantine for 14 days while avoiding direct contact with other people. These precautionary measures meet the recommendations issued by the Robert Koch Institute. After 14 days you can enter the school without hesitation.

In South Korea: Gyeongsangbuk-do province (North Gyeongsang)

4. Vivantes Wenckeback Clinic in Tempelhof on Albrechtstrasse (Mon-Fri 10 a.m. - 7 p.m. / Sun 10 a.m. - 5 p.m.)
5. Evangelical Hospital Queen Elisabeth Herzberge in Lichtenberg (Mon-Fri: 10 a.m. - 7 p.m.)
6. In addition, a test site is planned in the DRK Clinic Westend in Charlottenburg. It only opens later in the week.

The following applies to the Charité and the two Vivantes clinics: Before visiting, please ring the hotline of the Senate Health Administration (tel. 030/9028 28 28, daily 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.) to find out whether testing for the corona virus makes sense.

If you want to visit the Havelhöhe Hospital, please call the clinic's hotline first on Tel. 030 / 36501-7222.

The Herzberge Hospital wants to set up its own hotline, which is to be published on the website on Monday.

We would like to urge you to stay at home if you suspect you are ill or actually are ill and only come back to the university after the 14-day incubation period, i.e. when you are really healthy.
