Students can be released if they

- are outside the area of validity of the DST for at least three consecutive months (due to a semester abroad, internship, academy, etc.)
- are enrolled at another university and already receive the DST there
- are demonstrably enrolled more than one month after the start of the semester, are exmatriculated during the current semester, withdraw their enrolment, are granted retroactive leave of absence during the current semester or are demonstrably so seriously ill during the current semester that they would be entitled to a semester of leave of absence
- are unable to use public transportation due to their disability

BAFÖG, STUDENT CREDIT, AND STUDENT FUNDS

It is not always possible to cover the cost of your studies through a scholarship or through family funds. When nonmusical jobs begin to interfere with your progress, a renewed focus on your studies may become possible through student credit. The downside is that these funds must be repaid following completion of your degree. In such instances, BAföG is a favorable option, since according to the Federal Education Assistance Act, one half of such funding takes the form of repayment-free subsidy, and the other half is an interest-free loan. §8 of the Federal Education Assistance Act determines who is eligible for support through BAföG:

The AuslandsBAföG can also offer assistance if you are planning a stay abroad. Information on applying, as well as individual counseling on BAföG, is available from studierendenWERK Berlin at:

Also available are other credit options designed especially for students, and which therefore have lower interest rates than regular loans. All the same, taking out a loan should always be a stopgap solution. Further information on student credit and individual counseling is available from studierendenWERK Berlin at: https://www.stw.berlin/en/counselling/social-counselling-centre/overview-of-financing/

In addition, some foundations and associations offer students interest-free loans, for example, the Kuhlmann Stiftung and the Hildegardis Verein.

Another recently established form of financing is the Studienfonds. Participants invest funds in the future of students, and receive a return on their investment. One example is Deutsche Bildung AG. Like bank credit, the Studienfonds has a commercial background, and the amount that is repaid is as a rule higher than the amount of credit received – unlike BAföG and scholarships, where funds must be paid back only in part, or not at all. With the Studienfonds, however, repayment is always oriented toward the borrower's available income. Such assistance is often supplemented by nonmaterial support in the form of workshops or online seminars designed to enhance key competencies.


EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Those who unexpectedly find themselves in financial distress begin by searching desperately for short-term assistance. Temporary or time-limited grants can provide much-needed time during which the student can get reorganized and apply for more longrange financial support. In such circumstances, it is important to negotiate with institutions and enterprises concerning unpaid bills, to explain your situation, and, for example, to negotiate an extension or payment deferral.

In the event of sudden financial distress, the first point of contact at the Hanns Eisler is AStA, where you can apply for support during the most diverse financial emergencies, along with a subsidy for a semester ticket. Depending upon the availability of funds, the Society of Friends of the Hanns Eisler School offers short-term assistance to students who turn to them in need.

studierendenWERK Berlin offers emergency financial assistance in the form of subsidies from the Notfonds (emergency fund), as well as bridge loans. Information is available from the social counseling of studierendenWERK https://www.stw.berlin/beratung/sozialberatung/sozialberatung.html. The social counseling of studierendenWERK will also advise you concerning government social benefits such as Wohngeld and ALG II. For particularly disadvantaged students, studierendenWERK can provide grants for the start or conclusion of studies in the amount of €1000.



FUNDING AMOUNT

€1000

REQUIREMENTS

- Foreign students beginning in the second year of study (BA) or in the 2nd semester (MA), as well as concert exam students are eligible to apply
- · Outstanding achievement in your field
- · Social and/or intercultural engagement

SELECTION PROCESS

1st round: Pre-selection based on the documents submitted to the Services and International Affairs Office 2nd round: audition and interview before a multidisciplinary selection commission

As a rule in May of a given year

FUNDING TYPE

Annual scholarship for students in all major subjects and all nationalities

FUNDING AMOUNT

€300 per month

FUNDING PERIOD

1 year (from October to September); extension possible through reapplication

REQUIREMENTS

- · Enrollment at the Hanns Eisler School of Music Berlin
- · Support possible only within the standard period of study

SELECTION PROCESS

Awards are determined by a scholarship selection committee located within the school on the basis of the submitted application materials.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Generally in May of a given year

Financial award to support the development of an artistic project following completion of studies

FUNDING AMOUNT

€1000 monthly

FUNDING PERIOD

1 year

SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING

- · Monthly fixed allowance in the amount of €103
- Family allowance of €102.26 (scholarship holder with child), and €51.13 for each additional child
- · Special payments for travel costs possible

REQUIREMENTS

- · Far above-average qualification
- · Completion of a university degree in an artistic field
- The first degree must have been awarded no longer than three years ago; each additional degree (i.e. MA, concert exam) no longer than two years ago
- The candidate should not be enrolled in a program when applying; following acceptance of the award only, enrollment in an art/music academy in the Federal State of Berlin with mentoring by a professor (with full-time status).
- The candidate should receive no additional support from public resources for the same purpose

FUNDING AMOUNT

At least €540 monthly, depending upon the country group and the resources available from the EU

FUNDING PERIOD

3-12 months per study phase (BA, MA, concert exam)

SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING

for students with limited opportunities

REQUIREMENTS

- · Completion of at least the 2nd semester (for BA only)
- · As a rule, no applications in your home country
- · For non-EU citizens, a visa from the host country

SELECTION PROCESS

Once you have selected an Erasmus+ partner school, submit your application on time to your department. Following acceptance by the HfM, you can apply to the partner school. Please inform yourself concerning application procedures, deadlines, and the required documents, and get in touch with the contact listed below as soon as you have prepared everything.

FUNDING TYPE

Financial grant and nonmaterial support, for example counseling by a liaison instructor at the HfM as well as an advisor from the Foundation; events organized by the Foundation, for example concert series, summer academies, seminars, conferences

FUNDING AMOUNT

Basic stipend up to $\ensuremath{\in} 752$ monthly (amount dependent upon the family's financial situation)

FUNDING PERIOD

Funding period in accordance with to BAföG (corresponding as a rule to the standard period of study for the course of studies)

SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING

- · Allowance for study costs in the amount of €300 monthly
- · Grant for healthcare and health insurance (unless the student is insured through parents)
- · Family allowance and childcare allowance for recipients with children

REQUIREMENTS

- · Outstanding artistic achievement
- See Bafög § 8: German citizenship or Bildungsinländer*innen (German-educated foreign national), citizenship of an EU country, citizens of other countries with permanent residency permit, or having a spouse or parent with a permanent residency permit, or a parent who has been lawfully employed for at least 3 years in Germany during the past 6 years, as well as other special cases
- No support for second degrees (prior to the current course of studies, applicants can have studied other subjects for up to 4 (or voice majors, 6) semesters)
- Following the semester of the proposal to the Foundation, there must remain at least 2 semesters of the standard period of study

prior to graduation. In the case of the concert exam, it must be taken within one year or at the next possible point in time after completion of the previous stage of studies. An application during the final 2 semesters of a BA or MA program is possible as well, provided the student plans to continue on with an MA degree or concert exam. In the event of a positive decision, however, the foundation will provide support only provided that the student as admitted to the course of studies.

SELECTION PROCESS

1st round: after submitting application materials to the International Office, a selection audition and interview will take place at the HfM 2nd round: selection seminar at the Foundation




